

Washington State Trade with Poland (2011)

- Poland is Washington's 52nd largest export market, with **\$42.5 million** in products sent to the country in 2010.
- Washington product exports to Poland were 8% higher through May 2011 than for the year through May 2010.
- Washington's top export products to Poland in 2010 were: (1) Medical instruments; (2) Industrial machinery; (3) Seafood; (4) Electronics; and (5) Aircraft and parts.
- Exports of medical devices have dropped sharply through May 2011 compared to May 2010.
- Aerospace sales, meanwhile, have picked up to the tune of 140%, with aerospace exports through May 2011 already surpassing the annual total from 2010.
- Top products we export to Poland are: Ultrasonic scanning apparatus (\$9.3 million), Sockeye Salmon (\$7.3 million), Rotary Positive displacement Pumps (\$6.0 million), Steam/Sand blast machinery (\$3.0 million), and Civilian Aircraft (\$1.7 million).
- Some interesting products we export to Poland are: Lasers (#17), Pacific Salmon (#18), prepared Salmon (#19), Mink furskins (#22), Electrocardiographs (#28), Mixtures Odoriferous Substance Use Food/ Drink (#35), Loudspeakers (#50), cherries (#79), Essential Oils of Mints (#89), Grand Pianos (#117), Manicure or Pedicure preparations (#124)
